Naturally Phylloquinone is often called vitamin K1(fat soluble) and the simplest form of vitamin K is the synthetic menadione (K3), which has no side chain. Menaquinone-4 is synthesized in the liver from ingested menadione or changed to a biologically active menaquinone by intestinal microorganisms is an essential cofactor for hepatic precursors of coagulation factors II (prothrombin), VII, IX and X.

Indications: To treat/prevention bruisability, epistaxis, gastrointestinal bleeding and hematuria.

As an antidote for coumarin anticoagulants in hypoprothrombinaemia.

In Poultry: To arrest/prevent bleeding Especially during DEBEAKING and DETOEING, blood spot in eggs, hemorrhagic conditions like cocci, IBD, GDS and other vit. K deficiencies.

Dose:

Chicks, Growers : 50 gm per day for 3000 birds for 5 to 7 days.

During Coccidiosis : 1 gm in 5 ltr of water for 7 to 10 days.
