### THIAMINE (VITAMIN B1) CARBOHYDRATE METABOLISM.

**Indication**: Anorexia, Loss of Waight. Rutfied Feathers, Dropping of wings and Paralysis of muscles 'Star-Gazing

### RIBOFLAVIN (VITAMIN B2) ENZYME SYSTEMS.

**Indications**: Diarrhoea and "Curled Toe Paralysis" in birds between the first and second week of age.

The affected birds walk upon their hocks with the aid of their wings. In adult birds, decreased egg production, increased embryonic mortality and dead in shell chicks, with dwarfing and clubbing down feathers are seen,

Embryo mortality reaches a peak between 18 to 20 days of incubation

### PYRIDOXINE (VITAMIN B6) AMINO ACIDS METABOLISM.

**Indication**: Spasmodic convulsions and jerky movements are seen in sick birds

# CYANOCOBALAMIN (VITAMIN B12) NUCLEIC ACID SYNTHESIS, CARBOHYDRATE AND FAT METABOLISM AND METHYL TRANSFORMATION

**Indication**: Slowed growth, Poor feed utilisation and reduced hatchability. Embryonic mortality reaches peak on the 17th day of incubation

Myotrophy of legs and hemorrhage in the alantois of the embryo.

### Choline deficiency:

**Indications**: Purosis, Characterised by puffiness around the hock joint, Flattening of the tibio metatarsal joint and a twisting and bowing of the metatarsal with a sipping of the Achilles tendon from the condyle and abnormal fat in liver.
